DOES CHRIST HAVE A CHURCH TODAY?

A number of years ago a Chinese exchange student registered at an American university for a college education. On the entrance blank he was asked the question, "What is your religion?" His answer, written in the little English that he had learned, was "Confusion."

There are thousands of Americans who know the English language quite well, and who are now followers of Confucius, who could truthfully write that their religion is "Confusion." They really don't know enough about their belief to discover whether or not it is in accordance with what the Bible teaches. Many have inherited their religion from their parents or grandparents and they have never taken the time that is required to study the Bible and its teachings for themselves.

Perhaps this is part of the reason why 300 different denominations are found in the United States. Many of these churches teach theories diametrically opposed to one another and are not in harmony with the Bible doctrines. All too many deceive themselves by thinking that as long as they are sincere they will eventually reach the better land. But sincerity is not enough - we must also be right!

Every teaching comes either form the source of truth or it an attempt by the deceiver to mislead those who are seeking the way of eternal life. We cannot safely follow our feelings, for God has told us, "There is a way that **seemeth** right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death." Proverbs 16:25 (OT 532). If this is true and we believe it, we must be certain that we are accepting Bible truths and not error.

Has God given us any way of knowing what is truth? Is there any means by which we can tell what is the true Church? Are all churches right? How can I tell what to do and believe? God has not left us in darkness. Forseeing this very need He gave us a prophecy that answers the question. Let us study it now.
